

# All Saints Picnic in the park — Saturday, November 11th

Join the Bears for a day at McKinney Falls State Park on Nov. 11<sup>th</sup>.

McKinney Falls State Park is located 13 miles southeast of Austin. Travel on U.S. 183 to Scenic Loop Road, and then proceed 2 miles west to the park entrance at 7102 Scenic Loop Road. A day

fee of two dollars a person is required.

HOT Bears should arrive by noon with a picnic lunch (you can leave the fine crystal at home!). After eating we can hike around, walk through the woods, go bicycling, or just observe wildlife.

Onion Creek flows 1.7 miles though the park. The easy 3/4 mile Smith Rock Shelter interpretive trail begins at the visitor center, taking visitors past sights such as one of Travis Co. oldest bald cypress trees. Wildlife observation opportunities exist for armadillos, rock squirrels, whitetail deer numerous bird species. During the Fall, and Winter Spring, shorebirds and ducks are fairly common.

Come on out and have fun time in the park with the Bears.

We must, says the paradigm; there is no option. Anyone unfamiliar with gay culture will not understand how subversive it is to say to all-encompassing "We don't mindset: think so."

I am not a bear because I have body hair (though I do). I am not a bear because I have a beard and love beards on other men (though, Lordy, I do).

I am not even a bear because by and large bears present a more masculine image of the gay male than the twinks. I am a bear mainly because we fly in the hairless face of the elitist, exclusivist gay male culture that says some men worthy of friendship, affection, acceptance and some aren't. I love the bears because when we all get together, we're a11 pretty of accepting one another, even the smooth and hairless who might wander into our lairs. Contrast this to the atmosphere of pretension that pervades many gatherings what we've come to call

"The Twink Culture." We all know about it: "I'm better than you because: I'm thinner/ more muscular/driving more expensive vehicle/sporting other people's names on the ass of my jeans/sporting bigger joystick." Once I thought I was doomed to move around in that awful stuff if I wanted the company of my gay brothers. Which brings quickly, almost panicked, to my next thought: Thank vou thank you thank you, Bears everywhere and HOT Bears specifically, giving me community I can call mine.
