# The View from Buzzards' Peak



We are making a lot of improvements on the TCC Landsite.

I am happy to report that WiFi is going to be in and working by Lonestar. Lobo and Lee have been working with Hal to get the system up and running. All of the materials for this have been financed by donations, along with

labor provided by many other members of TCC. On-going costs will be met through a combination of user fees and donations.

We have planted about 200 saplings. As some of you may know, we have a serious problem with blight killing our older oak trees. To insure a forest, members have planted over 200 saplings of various blight resistant trees. It will take three to seven years for these to become evident, but planning now will

ensure a green future. TCC has also received a donation of 10 crepe myrtle trees by PWA Holiday Charities. They have also donated a large oleander bush planted as a memorial for one of their members. Placements of these will be around field perimeter and kitchen area, providing some flowering color in season to be enjoyed by all.

The TCC Trailer is getting a facelift. On the exterior, we have already repaired and replaced the deck and improved the steps. We have added a small roof covering for the front door (for rain), as well as a small shelf for a small bar. The entire trailer will get a new coat of paint. Landscaping with native plants will also make it a more inviting pace to stay. For the interior, we have a new mattress and new carpeting. We will paint the inside and give it a good cleaning. Again, this will be ready by Lonestar.

A day camping fee kiosk has been installed near the front. The HOT Bears donated 70% of the materials; others donated the rest. Eric and I built the structure. Tom, Harry, and Ed are working on a collection box and hope to have it ready for installation soon. The kiosk will also have the various TCC policies posted for day camping. It was deemed an important thing to have to help protect TCC from lawsuits arising from any unfortunate accident that might arise. Unfortunately, we live in litigious times. It would be horrible if a lawsuit shut the campground down- or even worse, we loose the land.

With new construction happening all over Milam County, new driving directions to the landsite are being created. Complete with photos of landmarks, the new instructions will aid new visitors to the landsite find their way.

A plan is in place to add another, small, bathroom and outdoor shower back in the Compound area. It is being funded by member donations. It is hoped that it will provide some relief to the overburdened toilets and showers already installed. Anyone who camps out in this area is going to appreciate a toilet that is an easier walk- especially late at night.

Activity Weekend for this month is April 27-29th. Come on up and enjoy the wildflowers in bloom, warm evenings, and the potluck dinner on Saturday. It's free to any HOT Bear members and their guests.

I encourage you all to get up to the landsite for events or a quiet weekend away. It is your facility and one of the great advantages to being a member of the HOT Bears.
