In the last few years the group has grown considerably, from 97 members in July 2005 to 147 members in July 2007. So we are very much now a true "*sleuth*" of bears. This expansion has been to a large part due to the nurturing of the out going board; Ed Burleson, Jack Landers, Mickey Ferguson and John Cowart. The goal of the out going board when they took on the job of steering the club in 2005, was to increase the membership and to increase the funds of the club in order to extend the wealth of activity that the group undergoes. The outgoing board have promoted and introduced great events such as BTTW and the Unrun.

We have now just completed the change over of the board to the new board. Personally I must say that I have a renewed admiration and understanding of the huge amount of work that the previous board has done for the club. As the new board, we would like to add to the great job that the old board has done. We would like to continue the theme of improving the activities of the group, in addition we would like to further promote the sense of community that we have within the club. To this end we are planning on increasing the variety of our offerings of social and voluntary charitable events.

In view of our goals as a new board and the size of the club, I thought it would be a great time to take stock of what the membership want from their club. As I teach statistics, I thought

that a member survey would be a great way of sleuthing out the wishes of the membership. To this end I have assembled a members survey, addressing the issues of the club activities you enjoy and what you would like to see more of in the club. In addition the survey addresses some broader questions about our *"sleuth"*. For instance, 'What do you peeps get from the club?', 'What are the strengths and weaknesses of the club?', and the ultimate question, 'How would you like to see the club grow & develop in order to keep the club vibrant and energetic for the future?'.

The survey is available online at www.HeartOf TexasBears.org/survey from 1st September to 21st September 2007. Once the survey is complete, I will collate the information and present the findings to you all through a series of bear brief articles. In addition, the board will also use the information in order to improve upon our activities for the membership to further promote community and sense of fun within the group.

The survey is modular, so please feel to contribute your views to all or part of the survey. Everyone who participates in the survey will be eligible for the drawing of prizes, which include a free enrollment to BTTW3s (or refund of the basic fees if you have already enrolled) or one of 5 new HOT Bears T-shirts. Names will be pooled and winners drawn randomly. The results will be published in next months *Bear Briefs* – so watch this space...
