From the President's Den — Back to the Woods Edition



On behalf of the 120+ members of the Heart Of Texas Bears,

Welcome to Back To The Woods 5!

We are so glad you are here with us for what promises to be another GREAT weekend of Fun, Laughter, and Friends here at the Texas Conference of Clubs land-site... "Buzzards' Peak". The HOT

Bears are one of many proud member clubs of TCC and welcome you to our own little piece of Central Texas.

Now that you have arrived, and found your bunkhouse/RV accommodations, and hopefully set up your tent without any major drama, a little more information about TCC and a trip around the land-site.

Chartered in 1975, the Texas Conference of Clubs long felt there should be a facility available for the men and women of our community to use as a campground, run-site, or retreat. In August of 1983, the Conference purchased a tract of land in Milam County, Texas to be used by the member clubs and others as a place for camping, holding runs or retreats, or just enjoying the great outdoors. This piece of land became known as Buzzards' Peak. The site is made up of tree-covered hills of cedar, hickory, gum, elm and oaks, with ravines, rocks, grassy areas and small wild animals. Since 1983 many improvements have been made to the land site. In addition to its increasing use by the member clubs, TCC now offers the use of the land site to interested community groups for their recreational functions.

One of the newest additions to the land-site is the medical shed at the end of the road entering the campsite. The Heart Of Texas Bears were instrumental in the construction of the building, and will be conducting an official dedication during the run with a cocktail party and ceremony.



Just up the hill and the across the road are the restroom facilities. Go down the hill and further into the campsite and you will find the showering facilities, full commercial style kitchen, the beverage cooler (where you will find all the cold beverages you care to drink) and the pole barn, where the Saturday show and masquerade ball will be held. To the left of the pole barn and up the hill you will be able to hike up to the summit of "Buzzards' Peak" and take in the scenery. Just down from the pole barn is the fire-pit, tent area and the head road up into the "compound" where many a late-night activity takes place. Curious???... just



Tips for a Great B2W5 Experience

We know you will enjoy your time at the campground over the weekend, but want to offer up these tips to make your camping experience a safe and enjoyable one.

- 1. When walking around the campsite, be mindful of tripping hazards (tree roots, rocks, tent stakes, etc...)
- 2. We recommend wearing closed toe shoes when hiking the trails, as the hills can be a little too steep and slippery for sandals or flip-flops.
- 3. Wear plenty of sunscreen during the day. Remember this is Central Texas and although the evenings and morning can be cool, the sun can really heat up in the afternoon.
- 4. Although mosquitoes are not a huge problem at the landsite, there are other biting insects that can really be annoying, so wear bug spray as needed. Bug spray will be available at the Medical Shed if needed.
- 5. In case of scrapes, cuts, etc... head to the medical shed where minor medical treatment will be available. In case of

- more serious emergencies, a hospital only minutes away.
- 6. We want your camping experience to be an enjoyable one, and want you to have as much fun as possible. But please be courteous of other campers around you and the land itself.
- 7. If you see a piece of litter lying on the ground, please place it in one of the appropriate waste receptacles located throughout the camp grounds. We want to be good stewards of what we have and your help will make this an enjoyable event for all.
- 8. Please help us help TCC by recycling your aluminum cans. You can deposit your cans in the container up near the beverage cooler where our very own Beverly Crusher will crush them or place them on the ground next to any waste receptacle located throughout the campground. The money collected goes back into the operation of the campsite. All other trash should be place in the waste receptacles.
